The *Polish Musicological Yearbook* is published annually by the Musicologists' Section of the Polish Composers' Union based in Warsaw, Poland. Both the board of editors and the owner of the journal are committed to upholding international standards of editorial ethics, transparency, and scientific integrity.

#### 1. Editorial and Peer Review Process

All submissions undergo double-blind peer review. Editorial decisions are based on academic merit, originality, and alignment with the journal's scope.

#### 2. Ethics and Editorial Responsibility

The editorial board ensures the quality and integrity of all publications. Cases of academic misconduct are handled according to COPE guidelines.

#### 3. Transparency of Information

Information about the editorial team, thematic scope, and submission guidelines is available on the journal's website.

#### 4. Open Access

The journal operates under an Open Access model – free of charge for both authors and readers.

### 5. Licensing

Articles are published under the Creative Commons Attribution-ShareAlike 4.0 International License (CC BY-SA 4.0).

### 6. Preventing Misconduct

All texts are checked for originality. The editorial team follows COPE procedures in the event of ethical violations.

## 7. Source Transparency

Authors are required to accurately cite all sources, including literature, manuscripts, and archival documents, scores and recordings, .

#### 8. Conflict of Interest

Authors, reviewers, and editors must disclose any potential conflicts of interest.

## 9. Publication Frequency

The journal is published once a year.

## 10. Archiving and DOI

Each article receives a DOI. Publications are archived on the journal's website and in repositories of other scientifical platforms, such as Sciendo and the Biblioteka Nauki.
